In 1984 we officially became the first Habitat for Humanity affiliate in Wisconsin, and tenth in the nation.

Chapters in Dodgeville, Portage and Platteville soon followed.

Today, Habitat for **Humanity of Wisconsin** River Area serves five counties across southcentral Wisconsin. Our combined history offers the opportunity to serve more families in need of affordable housing.
